

Fishing Report 25th October 2021

As we head into the penultimate week of the season it's been lovely to welcome back some of our longstanding regulars who we haven't seen since the start of the pandemic.

The fishing has proven a little tougher this week, with a fairly mixed bag of weather and a noticeable drop in the temperature mid-week. However we still have a very healthy rod average of 3.73, which is the highest rod average for this week of the season since 2015!

Most anglers have found success with intermediate or sinking lines at a depth of ten foot and below, drifting between Fishtail Creek and the Dam Wall. Fry patterns have worked well, but we've also seen some success on dries up at the North End.

Due to daylight hours reducing we will now be fishing 8.30am - 5.30pm, with this dropping back to a 4.30 finish at the end of the week with the changing of the clocks.

Last Day of Fishing - Sunday 7th November 2021

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was 3.73 with 205 fish caught by 55 anglers.

Best Rainbow

The heaviest Rainbow was 4lb 1oz caught by Mr Wood. The heaviest Brown was 4lb 8oz caught by Mr Cummins.

Methods & Flies

Fish have been caught using intermediate or sinking lines at a depth of 10 foot and below. Di5 lines and fry patterns have been well used this week. Some anglers have found success with dry flies up towards the North End.

The most successful flies have been minkies, orange blobs, pink or white snakes, sparkle boobies, black and blue lures and cats whiskers.

Top Spot

The most popular spots have been Fishtail Creek to the Dam Wall and buoys 8 and 10.

Wheelyboat Fund Raising Project for Carsington Water Fishery

Tony Higton, who supports our fishery with many aspects including our popular open competitions, is working closely with the Wheelyboat Trust to raise funds for a 3rd wheelyboat. Over the past year we have seen an increased need for more access boats of this kind. We have many anglers who use this due to a disability, ill health, or temporary conditions whilst recovering from treatment or an operation.

Tony's aim is to raise just over £13,000 for a new coulam wheelyboat, including push start engine and seats. Tony has already been busy looking at grant applications from all around the local area with donations already being pledged via the Ashbourne Freemasons. The Wheelyboat trust are the principal fundraiser and they have kindly set up a CAF fund raising page to help increase the funding level and meet Tony's target.
