

Fishing Report – Monday 3rd April 2023

The week started out cloudy, wet with a brisk north easterly breeze. Many anglers have been practicing for the Grey's pair competition on Sunday. We will have more details on how the competition got on later in the report. I think it's fair to say that the time put in practicing certainly paid off.

On Monday 3 of our regular anglers Mr Duffield, Scragg and Critchley all caught well mostly in Brown Ale bay using a slow retrieve on sinking lines with buzzers. The poor weather report of Tuesday only saw one boat booked Mr Wood braved the elements catching just a couple of fish once again on buzzer. Wednesday was good day with a number of boats recording double figures to the boat, reports of fish all over with black buzzers, leaches and black blobs being the order of the day.

On Thursday the winds stayed strong but produced some great buzzer fishing, many boats kept on the east side in the shelter. A number of large fish were recorded of over 4lbs.

Saturday was the final practice day before the Grey's Pair match. The winds were much lighter and allowed many to fish in Brown Ale bay and around the Osprey Towers. There was a real mix with some anglers catching 20 plus fish and their boat partners catching far less. It amazing how fishing the same methods from the same boat can often produce such different returns. Many were still fishing intermediate and sinking lines on a slow retrieve using black buzzers or black tadpole.

On Sunday we played host to the Grey's Pairs. 15 boats fished the competition with the first boat returning to the lodge after catching their 8 fish in just 45 minutes.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **5.50** with 380 fish caught by 69 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 5lb 8oz caught by Chad Critchley on sinking line, fishing buzzer.

The heaviest Brown was 4lbs 90z caught by Tony Smith caught in Brown Ale Bay.

Methods & Flies

Fish have been caught using mostly sinking lines on a slow retrieve.

The most successful flies were black & green lures, black tadpoles, orange booby, baby doll, damsels, and black or red buzzers which have been the most popular fly of the week.

Top Spot

The most popular spots have been Brown Ale Bay, Osprey Towers, Millfields, Sailing club island, Fish Tail Creek and Stitch Plantation.

Grey's Pairs - Carsington Heat

Sunday's heat of the Grey's Pairs qualifier produced some amazing bags and excellent fishing.

Every pair catching at least five fish and best bag weighing over 23lb. Todays winners were Mick McClintic & Gary Owen, they were also the first boat in at 10:45. They caught their fish off the Osprey Poles, fishing di7's and two boobies. second place went to Lee Cartmel & Pete Eville, catching their fish on di7's again but fishing a single snake fly.

The final place were separated by 5 ounces of which Rens Delrosso & Mike Dixon were on the right side of the result.

Many of the anglers who weighed in earlier in the day went back out to please fish and continued to catch after their 4 fish bag limit.

It was great to play host to this event and we wish the qualifiers luck in the finals later in the year.

Casting Tuition for Beginners

Intro to fly fishing from a boat

Whether you have little or no experience to in fly fishing from a boat. Our 3 hours boat fishing experience sessions will give you a point in the right direction.

Our qualified Game Fishing coach will give an introduction to safe boat driving and boat etiquette. Casting from the boat, fishing at anchor or on the drift plus best of all reading the weather conditions and finding the favoured fishing spot for the day. Hopefully catching a one of our beautiful rainbow trout to complete your experience. We are able to accommodate 2 people in the boat with our coach on each session. You can choose to book this session on a private basis or share the experience with another like minded angler.

Each session will last approx 3 hours.
