

# Fishing Report 4th July 2022

It's once again been a mixed bag of weather this past week with wet and windy days interspersed with warm, sunny ones leading to a full array of lines and flies proving successful. We're pleased to say the rod average has risen to 2.54, with a good number of weighty rainbows being recorded.

It was fantastic to welcome back Miles Hilton-Barber and his son David on Monday for a cracking first visit of the season. They landed eleven to the boat including a 4lb rainbow for David, who was beaten to heaviest rainbow of the week by Miles with a fabulous 4lb 6oz rainbow. Great to have you back with us chaps!

Mr Bond and Mr Pickles joined us on Thursday and took ten to the boat including a 3lb 4oz rainbow. They found success across the water, but gave special mention to the mid-lake area. Fishing Di5 and Di6 line with white lures or black and green tadpoles on a slow retrieve was their method of choice. Fantastic day, well done.

On Saturday long-standing regular Paul Pearce and his boat partner Charlie Holmes took 9 to the boat, with each of them bagging a 4lb rainbow. They fished around buoy 0 - 10 using black snakes on a back drift. Great work!

#### Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **2.54** with 71 fish caught by 28 anglers.

#### **Best Rainbow/Brown**

The heaviest Rainbow was 4lb 6oz caught by Miles Hilton-Barber.

The heaviest Brown was 3lb caught by Peter Mansfield.

## **Methods & Flies**

Fish have been caught using floating, intermediate and sinking lines - very much weather dependant, with fishing a slow retrieve recommended by many.

The most successful flies were green boobies, black & pink snakes, black & green tadpoles, bosworths and white lures.

## **Top Spot**

The most popular spots have been Fishtail Creek, the valve tower and dam wall, the main basin and buoys 0, 3 and 10.
