



Fishing Report - Week ending Sun 13th July 2025

Another hot week with a mixture of flat calm to breezy conditions.
The rod average has increased slightly to 3.21.

Most anglers have fished the deeper section of the water at anchor or the most the popular option of drifting across or down the middle of the water.

There has still been a mixture of techniques with some using sinking lines either stripping them back quite quickly or letting them drop slowly. Others preferred to fish a floating line and managed to tempt the fish closer to the surface. Despite a number of anglers struggling to get fish to the boat some of our regular anglers have caught between 5 - 11 fish.

The coming week is looking much cooler, some days may be breezy, and we may even see some rain.....

Methods & Flies

Most popular methods have been floating lines, Midge Tips, fast sinking lines or slow sinking lines.
The most popular flies have been buzzers, orange blobs, orange lure, pink snakes and black snakes.
