



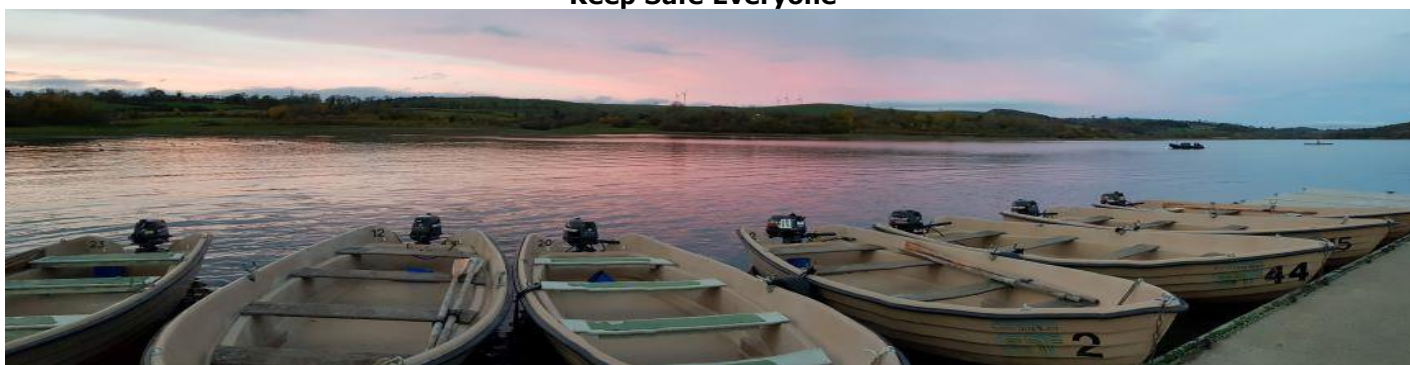
Fishing Report 2nd November 2020

Rod Average

The rod average for this weekend was **2.14** with 47 fish caught by 22 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbows were 4lb 8oz caught by Mr Beeston & Mr Wolstenholme.

The heaviest Brown was 3lb caught by Mr Robinson.

Methods & Flies

The most successful flies were fry, blobs, boobie minkies, snakes and black and green lures.

Fish have been caught using sinking lines on the drift, with Di3 or Di5 lines proving most popular.

Top Spot

The most popular spots have been by Tower Bank, the North End and Fishtail Creek.
