



A mixed bag of weather brought about a mixed bag of fishing with rainbows, browns and blues being caught this week. Most fish have been caught on the eastern side of the reservoir whilst drifting using sinking or intermediate lines, with various lures, orange being the favourite colour.

The rod average for this week was **2.74** with 129 fish caught by 47 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow was 3lb 4oz caught my Mr P Harding The Heaviest brown caught was 2lb 10oz caught by Mr B Needham

Top Spot

Popular areas this week have been fish tail creek, buoys 4,5 & 6 and Millfields. Anglers are now moving out into the deeper water as the water temperatures rise.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were orange cats whisker, orange blob, orange tag, grey minkie, damsel nymphs and bobs bits.

Most anglers have used intermediate and sinking lines.
