Our Autumn Open competition was a well-supported day with 18 boats competing for the 2016 Autumn trophy. The weather stayed fine and sunny with a steady breeze throughout the day from the north.

A total of 165 fish were caught by 35 anglers during the competition

Mike Frith and Richard Haughton were the overall winners, catching 12 fish and a total bag weight including time bonus of 29lbs 10oz. Richard had actually travelled all the way from Fife and had a great days fishing. Let's hope we can persuade him to travel down for the Spring Open in 2017!

The most popular spots have been around buoys 4 and 5, Dam wall, Fishtail Creek and middle of the reservoir

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were both wet and dry flies including Boobies, Hot Head Damsels, Orange Blob, Montana, Claret Bumble, Ace of Spades

Floating, intermediate and sinking lines have all been used this week.
