Another busy week on the water but with a mix of conditions some anglers have found the fishing harder going than last week. Despite this many anglers have still produced catches well into double figures, Buzzers have once again been popular and fished very successfully.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **6.88** with 688 fish caught by 100 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 4lb by Mr D Hosfield

The heaviest brown caught this week was 3lb 4oz by Mr Cozens

Top Spots

Popular areas this week have been Millfields, Upperfields Bay, Watersports Island, Tower Bank and Brown Ale Bay.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were black buzzers, gold head montana, hot head damsels, ace of spades, cats Whisker, diawl Bach and buzzers.

Most anglers have used intermediate and floating lines.
