



Fishing Report 12th June 2017

It's been a quiet week at Carsington due to high winds for the first four days. Despite this the weekend gave more favourable conditions resulting in an acceptable rod average of 4.45.

Evening Fishing

We are now fishing until 9.30pm and evening tickets are available from 5pm (£12, 2 fish bag limit). These must be purchased by 6pm before reception closes. It's also worth calling ahead to check availability of boats.

All boats must be back to the jetty by 9.30 and no later.

Please respect this finish time as our wardens have several duties after the boats have returned.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **4.47** with 152 fish caught by 34 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 2lbs 9oz caught by Mike Frith.

The heaviest Brown was 3lbs 2oz caught by Max Peacock.

Top Spot

The most popular spots have been around Shiningford, Millfields, Tower Bank and sailing club & Watersports Island.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were both wet and dry flies including black fritz, pink snakes, white snakes, black & green lure, white marabou, black buzzer, cruncher, hoppers, mayfly and bibio.

The main method this week has been floating lines and many have been using the washing line method.

Autumn Open Competition – Saturday 7th October 2017

Carsington is a great venue for Fly fishing competitions and following the success of both our Spring and Autumn competitions we are pleased to announce the date for the 2017 Autumn Open on Sat 7th October 2017.

The Carsington Autumn Open competition is aimed at all anglers who enjoy a day's boat fishing with a friend. It will be an organised event based on two people per boat with an individual bag limit of 6 fish. Prizes will be awarded for the winning pair with the heaviest collective bag and a number of individual prizes.

The cost of entry will be 60.00 per pair including permits and petrol boat hire.

25 Year Anniversary Tagged Fish Competition

To mark Carsington Water's 25th Anniversary we have launched a tagged fish competition. We have released 25 tagged fish into the reservoir with a number of prizes to be won for those caught throughout the 2017 season.

To date 13 of the 25 fish have been caught so lots more prizes up for grabs.
