The rod average for this week was **8.96** with 475 fish caught by 53 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow this week was 3lbs caught on a damsel by Mr G Stephenson. The heaviest brown caught was 3lbs caught by Lee Hemmings.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been mostly on the west side of the reservoir including stone island, sailing club island, north end, millfields and the Dam wall.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were gold head montana, cats whisker, damsels, black buzzers, zonkers and diawl bachs. Most fish have been caught on floating and intermediate lines, close to the shore lines.
