Fishing Report 13th June 2016

A very calm bright start to the week which produced some good returns on Monday despite the balmy summer weather! Unfortunately the weather then deteriorated over the week and the sun disappeared. Winds remained light throughout the week and many fisherman were able to catch on Buzzers and Nymphs. Intermediate and floating/sink tip lines produced the best results.

Quite a few Brown Trout are now starting to show up on the catch returns.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **4.53** with 372 fish caught by 82 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 3lb 12oz caught by Mr Riley
The heaviest Brown was 4lbs caught by Mr Williams

Top Spot

The most popular spots have been Tower Bank, Millfields and the Watersports Island

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were Black Buzzers, Damsels, Boobies, Bibios and Montana. Intermediate and Floating/Sink Tip lines have proved the most successful.
