14th July 2014

Tough conditions this week have given us a rod average of 2.95. Many fisherman have reported success with dry flies on the surface above the weed beds.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was 2.95 with 233 fish caught by 79 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow this week was 3lbs both Mr Hild and Mr Delahay catching a fish this size.

The heaviest brown caught was 2lbs 7oz caught by Mr Keeling.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been North End, Dam Wall, Brown Ale Bay, Fishtail Creek. Fish have been reported over the whole of the reservoir.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were gold head montana, hares ears, damsel nymph, ace of spades, diawl bachs, orange blob, black fritz, cats whisker, lead bugs, claret popper hopper and black hoppers.

Most fish have been caught whilst drifting across deeper areas of the lake and also using dry flies on the surface above the weed beds towards the edges of the reservoir.
