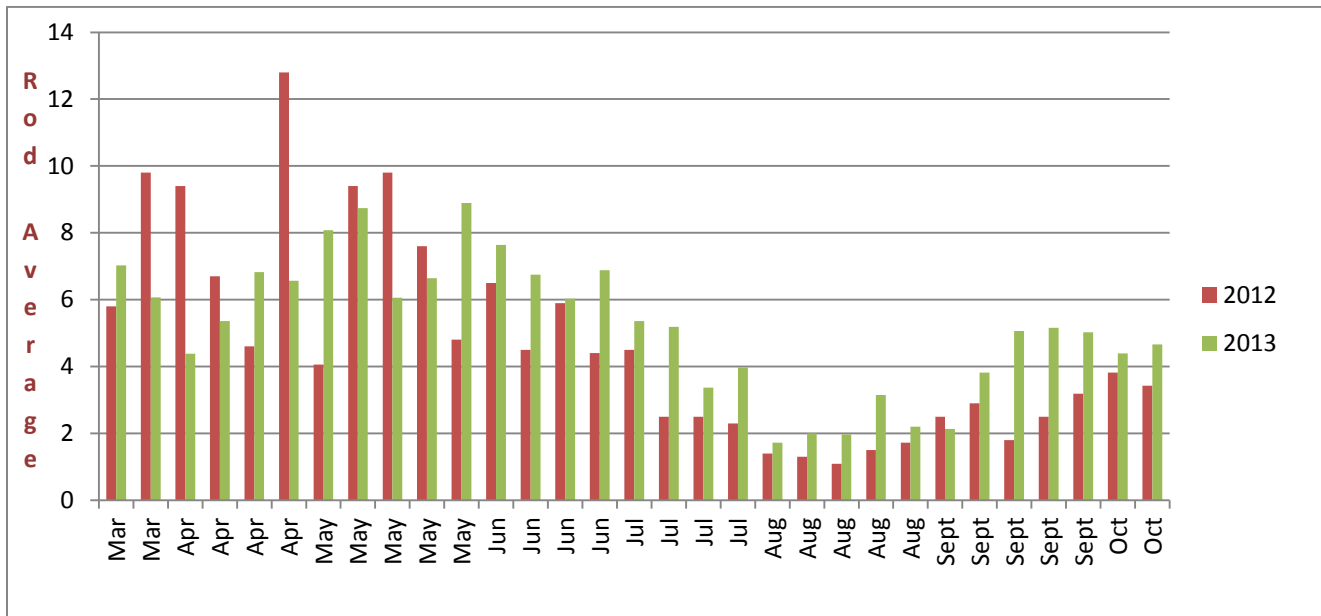


Carsington Fishery Report 14th October 2013

It's good to see that the rod average has held above 4 for this week despite the blustery weather over the weekend. This didn't seem to put those off who ventured to the far side finding shelter in the mouth of Fishtail creek, which is currently our top fishing spot.



Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **4.66** with 173 fish caught by 37 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow this week was 3lbs 15oz caught on a montana in Fishtail creek on a sinking line by Mr P Pearce. The heaviest Brown caught this week was 2lbs 8oz. It was caught by Mr Neale in the middle of the reservoir on a floating line.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been at the Halfmoon Field, Stitch Plantation, Fishtail Creek, the middle of the reservoir, Upperfields bay and the Millfields.

Method & Flies

The most successful patterns are Ace of spades, gold head montana, cats whisker, booby, goldhead orange and red blobs, daddies, black buzzer and black hoppers.

Fish have been caught on all types of line including sinking lines on a fast retrieve. Many anglers have still been fishing on a drift from the east side of the reservoir into the deeper water especially around Fishtail creek.

Fishing Regulations

Please note that our fishing regulations are printed on the reverse of your permit.

Currently some of these rules are not being adhered to.

Please take particular notice of,

Rule 6 – Trolling is not permitted. No fly lines are to be in the water when the boat is under power.
