Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Browns were 3lb caught by Mr Lang and Mr Callaghan

Top Spot

The most popular spots have been Shiningford Creek, Sailing Club Island, Watersports Island and Sitch Plantation

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were Cat's Whiskers, Montanas, Buzzers, Damsels and Pink Snakes
Intermediate Lines on a slow retrieve have been used.
