

Carsington Fishery Report 16th September 2013

The rod average is 5.06 for this week which is an increase on last week and much better than this time last year. The cooler temperatures seemed to have helped the fish to show in shallower areas and closer to the surface. The Northwest Fly Fishers braved the elements yesterday having a successful trip with Mr Ratcliffe catching our biggest fish of the week.



Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **5.06** with 349 fish caught by 69 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow this week was 4lbs 10oz caught by Mr S Ratcliffe. A number of browns were caught but no weights were recorded.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been at the North End, Halfmoon Field, Stitch Plantation, Fishtail Creek and the Dam Wall.

Method & Flies

The most successful patterns are Montana, cats whisker, white minkie, red blobs, daddies, gold head hares ear, and hoppers.

More fish have been caught on intermediate and floating lines, it's been great to see reports of fish being caught on the surface especially on daddies.
