

Fishing Report 17th July 2017

The rod average has held at just over 2. A few cooler days have held the water temperatures, however many fish are being caught in deeper water in the main basin of the reservoir.

As the nights are drawing back in this will be our last week of fishing until 9.30 so don't miss out. Remember we still have 10 tagged fish to be caught and 10 £25 vouchers to be won!

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **2.16** with 106 fish caught by 49 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 3lbs 5oz caught by M Margett.

The heaviest Brown was 2lb 12oz caught by D Saunders.

Top Spot

The most popular spots have been around North End, Fishtail creek, Brown Ale Bay, main basin, Buoy 5 and behind the islands.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were both wet and dry flies including white fritz, white lure, bibio, snakes, black & green lure, hopper and blood worm.

Floating lines through to sinking lines have been used this week
