17th November 2014



The colder water means the weed around the banks is dying away allowing many fisherman to find fish closer in to the banks than previous weeks.

As the winter weather draws in we have fewer boats available so it is best to book ahead to guarantee yourself a boat! Especially for those final few hours of the season on closing weekend!

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **2.06** with 37 fish caught by 18 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 4lb 2oz by Mr Harding.

The heaviest brown caught this week was 2lb 12oz caught by Mr Pearce.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been North Island, Half moon, Stitch plantation, Upperfields bay, Fishtail creek and Millfields with many finding fish closer to the bank.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were booby, minkie, white fritz, black and red, gold head, cruncher, black & green lure, cats whisker, montana and leeches.

Various methods have been successful from Floating through to Sinking lines.
