





Carsington Fishing Report

18th August 2014



The windy conditions seem to have helped a little with the water temperatures and fishing conditions, resulting in an increased rod average of 3.15!

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **3.15** with 104 fish caught by 33 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 3lbs 13oz by Ian McGrath by Buoy 5 on a montana. The heaviest brown caught this week was 2lbs by Mr Neale in the middle of the reservoir on a popper.

<u>Top Spots</u>

The most successful areas have been North End, Dam Wall, Brown Ale Bay, Millfields and the middle of the reservoir.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were daddies, bibio, sedges, montana, popper, blobs, and black hoppers. Most fish have been caught whilst drifting across deeper areas of the reservoir using dry flies on the surface others have been successful a sub surface in the cooler water fishing on lures and boobies. Generally fish have not been caught deep down which would be normal for this time of year.
