#### Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **5.1** with 474 fish caught by 93 anglers.

#### **Best Rainbow/Brown**

The heaviest Rainbow was 3lbs 8oz caught by Alex Haywood. The heaviest Brown was 4lbs 4oz caught by Samantha Edmunds.

#### Top Spot

The most popular spots have been around Shiningford, Brown Ale, Millfields, Tower Bank, Fishtail creek and sailing club & Watersports Island.

# Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were both wet and dry flies including nymphs, damsel, pin fry, white snakes, black & green lure, white marabou, black buzzer, cruncher, hoppers, mayfly and bibio.

The main method this week has been floating lines and many have been using the washing line method.
