The police held their Imperial Trophy competition this week. Seven teams from various regions competed in groups. Cheshire were crowned the overall winners with 41 fish caught. Derbyshire and Leicestershire were joint runners up each team catching 25 fish. Rod average for the competition was 5.67. Dave Allen of Cheshire Police was announced as top angler with 12 fish caught. This weekend see's British Summer Time ending and the clocks go back by 1 hour meaning that the jetty clock will be changing to 4.30 on Sunday The 2015 fishing season ends on Sunday 1st November and we will be re-opening for 2016 on the 12th March

The most successful patterns were Orange Blob, Dabblers, Black and Green Fritz, Nymphs, Minkies, Pink Snake and Cat's Whisker's.

Intermediate and sinking lines caught the most fish this week.
