The fishing picked up for the last week of the season giving many anglers a rewarding trip out in the colder conditions.

We finished the season with a rod average of 4.68 with many anglers catching fish into double figures.

### Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **4.68** with 103 fish caught by 22 anglers.

### Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 4lb 11oz by Mr Margett.

The heaviest brown caught this week was 3lb 12oz caught by Mr Allison.

### Top Spots

The most successful areas have been North End, Half moon, Brown Ale Bay, Upperfields bay and Fishtail creek with many finding fish closer to the bank.

### Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were blobs, booby, minkie, dry flies, black and red, pink lures, black & green lure, cats whisker, montana and leeches.

Various methods have been successful from Floating through to Sinking lines.
