The rod average has dropped a little following the effects of a windy weekend.

It has been great to see many new faces out on the water. Hopefully you have all enjoyed your visit and we will see you again through out the season.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **6.92** with 574 fish caught by 83 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 4lbs by Mr D Pendlebury.
The heaviest brown caught this week was 2lbs 12oz by Mr P Pearce.

Top Spots

Popular areas this week have been Tower Bank, Sheepwash, Brown Ale Bay, Watersports Island, Dam wall and Millfields.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were Black Buzzers, green buzzer, shipmans buzzer, damsel nymph, Diawl Bach, Gold Head Montana, Hot Head Damsels, bibio, black spider and black pannel.
Most anglers have used intermediate and floating lines.
