

# Fishing Report 1<sup>st</sup> May 2017

It's been a colder week with some challenging wind conditions however, the rod average is still at a respectable **6.9**. Many fish have been seen rising and lots have been caught on buzzer.

We have a lot of nesting birds on the islands close to Millfields and Shiningford Creek, please keep well away from these islands when fishing.



## Rod Average

The rod average for this week was 6.9 with 599 fish caught by 86 anglers.

#### Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 4lbs caught by Mr Freeguard. The heaviest Brown was 4lbs 2oz caught by Tony Cleaver.

## Top Spot

The most popular spots have been around North End, Halfmoon field, Stitch Plantation, Fishtail Creek, sailing club island, Buoy 5 & 6 and Millfields.

## Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were both wet and dry flies including cormorant, orange lure, black & green lure, viva, montana, hot head damsel, cruncher, black buzzer, Boobies, cats whisker and dabbler.

A whole range of methods have been used this week, floating, intermediate and sinking lines.
