Most areas of the reservoir have proved popular this week. Fishtail Creek, Tower Bank, Osprey Towers and Millfields all producing good fishing.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were gold head montana, booby, minkie, black and green lures and buzzers.

Most anglers have used intermediate to sinking lines on a fast retrieve.
