

Fishing Report 20<sup>th</sup> June 2016

Predominately north winds and days of rain made for a mixed bag of fishing methods on the catch returns. Warmer water on the margins has started to push fish further out with fish being caught whilst drifting across the centre of the reservoir. The weed banks are now starting to flourish particularly on the west side of the reservoir. The weekend saw some fish showing on the surface, but reluctant to take flies. Please remember to fill in your catch returns and post them in the box. These really help us compile the reports and help pass on information to other anglers, especially new customers to the water and to the sport.
