Once again a great week at the fishery with the rod average increasing to 6.64.

On Thursday we hosted the Police Sport UK Regional Eliminator with teams competing from Derbyshire, Nottinghamshire, Leicestershire, Northamptonshire and Lincolnshire, they all had a great day with 30 out of 32 anglers all catching their 6 fish bag limit.

Rod Average

The rod average for last week was 6.64 with 551 fish caught by 83 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The top spots this week have been Tower Bank, North of Brown ale bay, halfmoon field, fishtail creek, Upperfileds bay and sailing club island.

Method & Flies

The most popular fly patterns used this week have been nymphs, buzzers, hares ears, daiwl bach, orange booby, hot head damsel and gold head montana. Mostly intermediate and floating lines have been used this week.
