# **Carsington Fishing Report**

21st July 2014

It has been another hard week of fishing with warm still conditions. Most anglers have had success in deeper water on the edge of the weed beds. Also the North end of the reservoir seems to be fishing very well with the use of floating lines and dry flies.



Remember the tagged fish is still out there to be caught.

# **Rod Average**

The rod average for this week was 2.37 with 109 fish caught by 46 anglers.

## **Best Rainbow/Brown**

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 3lbs 9oz by Tony Clever at the North End The heaviest brown caught was 2lbs 4oz caught by Paul Pearce at the North End on a Cats Whisker.

### Top Spots

The most successful areas have been North End, Dam Wall, Brown Ale Bay, Fishtail Creek. Fish have been reported over the whole of the reservoir.

## **Methods & Flies**

The most successful patterns were gold head montana, hares ears, damsel nymph, ace of spades, diawl bachs, orange blob, black fritz, cats whisker, lead bugs, claret popper hopper and black hoppers.

Most fish have been caught whilst drifting across deeper areas of the lake and also using dry flies on the surface above the weed beds towards the edges of the reservoir.
