Our first full week of fishing could not have gone any better! Several fishermen have been landing 30+ fish to the boat and the rod average has increased! Orange blobs, Pink snakes and Black & Green Lures have been used to great effect. The water levels are continuing to rise which should help the fishing areas even more!

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was 10.67 with 694 fish caught by 65 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 4lb caught by Mr S Wilson The heaviest Brown was 3lb caught by David Ramsay

Top Spot

Popular areas this week have been Half Moon, Tower Bank, Sheepwash, Fishtail Creek and Stitch Plantation.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were Orange Blob, Black and Green fritz, Cat's Whiskers, Cormorant and Pink Snakes. Sinking and intermediate lines have seen the best results.
