
Carsington Fishery Report 21st October 2013

The rod average has increased to an incredible **6.29** for this week there has been some great fishing, it's been interesting to read that most fish have been caught close to the surface.

We are open for fishing until 24th November and as from next week fishing will be 8.30 – 4.00 so there will not be any afternoon tickets available. You can still however have a half day morning ticket until 2pm.



Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **6.29** with 302 fish caught by 48 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow this week was 5lbs 3oz caught on a dry fly in Fishtail creek by Mr P Harding. The heaviest Browns caught this week were 1lbs 12oz caught by Mr Neal and Mr Barber on floating lines.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been at the Halfmoon Field, Stitch Plantation, Fishtail Creek, the middle of the reservoir, Upperfields bay and the Millfields.

Method & Flies

The most successful patterns are Cormoran, Minky, Ace of spades, gold head montana, cats whisker, booby, goldhead orange and red blobs, minnows and pheasant tail nymph.

Fish have been caught on all types of line including sinking lines on a fast retrieve. Many anglers have still been fishing on a drift from the east side of the reservoir into the deeper water especially around Fishtail creek.
