Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbows this week were 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ lbs caught by J Matthews and G Stevens. The heaviest brown this week was 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ lbs caught by P Pearce.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been in deeper water areas towards the North end., Fish tail creek, Upperfields, Millfields and off sailing club island.

Method & Flies

The most successful patterns are black lures, cats whiskers, sedges, fry patterns and hot head damsels. Most fish have been caught in deeper areas on intermediate and sinking lines due to the hot weather and warmer water temperature near to the surface.
