Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **6.26** with 551 fish caught by 88 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 4lbs caught by Mr O'Brien.
The heaviest Brown was 2lbs 12oz caught by Mr P Eville

Top Spot

Popular areas this week have been Tower Bank, Halfmoon field, Fishtail creek, Upperfields bay, Watersports Island, Dam wall and Millfields. These areas were mostly depicted by the wind directions of the past week.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were small Black Buzzers, Ace of Spades, Cats whisker, Cruncher, Damsel Nymph, Diawl Bach, Gold Head Montana, Bibio, Claret Hoppers, Black Spider and May fly.
It's been great to see more fish caught on dry flies this week, especially the May fly.
Most anglers have used intermediate and floating lines.
