We have had some lovely browns caught this week just like the one shown above. Some anglers have been successful whilst dapping and also caught on dries.

We only have 1 week left of the season so don't miss out on some great fishing. Our last day is this Sunday 29th October, this is a little earlier than normal due to reduced water levels.



Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **2.7** with 116 fish caught by 43 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 4lb 2oz caught by Mark Lee The heaviest Brown was 3lb 6oz caught by David Barber The heaviest Blue were 4lbs caught by Graham Watts and John Harding

<u>Top Spot</u>

The most popular spots have been around the Main Basin, Fish Tail Creek, North Islands, Sheep Wash and Buoy 3.

Methods & Flies

The most successful flies were daddies, damsels, hoppers, cats whiskers and minkies.

Many anglers have fished on a drift using lures with intermediate or slow sinking lines.
