

Carsington Fishery Report 23rd September 2013

There has been a small increase in the rod average to 5.16. Lots of great fish over 3lbs have been caught on intermediate and floating lines. The current weather conditions have produced some excellent fishing days, cooler water temperatures and pleasant air temperatures.



Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **5.16** with 315 fish caught by 61 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow this week was 4lbs caught by Mr L Whitehead, this was one of 10 fish that he caught throughout the day. The heaviest brown was 2lbs caught by M.P Wood.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been at the North End, Halfmoon Field, Stitch Plantation, Fishtail Creek, Millfields and the Dam Wall.

Method & Flies

The most successful patterns are Montana, cats whisker, booby, goldhead orange blobs, daddies, pheasant tail nymph, and hoppers.

More fish have been caught on intermediate and floating lines.
