Despite another tough week with cold windy conditions many anglers have caught large numbers of fish with many catch returns recording double figures. It's been great to see a number of brown trout also being caught. Let's hope for some warmer weather for the next few weeks and some great fishing.

#### **Rod Average**

The rod average for this week was **4.80** with 246 fish caught by 48 anglers.

#### **Best Rainbow/Brown**

The heaviest rainbow this week was 3lbs 8oz caught on a viva near the island by Mr R Crompton. The heaviest brown was 2lbs 4oz caught on a cats whisker near Tower bank by Mr P Allison.

#### **Top Spots**

The most successful areas have been at Shiningford creek, Watersports island, Sheepwash and some caught in the middle of the reservoir.

#### **Methods & Flies**

The most successful patterns are black & orange montana, orange fritz, green Montana, cats whisker and orange booby. Most fish have been caught on intermediate and sinking lines.

### Will your float vest float?

All gas inflate lifejackets and float vests rely on a simple gas cylinder to fire should you ever fall into the water either from a boat or the bank. Every year we vigorously test our lifejackets and check the firing system to ensure all our customers are safe when afloat. In the pictures above you can see an example of a customers float vest where the firing system is out of date - this means there is no guarantee the gas will deploy when needed. Please check the expiry date on your float vest prior to your next fishing trip and replace if needed.
