Rod Average

The rod average for this week was 2.2 with 55 fish caught by 25 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 6lb by Mr Hind.

The heaviest brown caught this week was 2lb 7oz caught by Mr Frith.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been Sailing Club Island, Half moon, Brown Ale Bay, Upperfields bay, Fishtail creek and Millfields with many finding fish closer to the bank.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were booby, minkie, dry flies, black and red, gold head, cruncher, black & green lure, cats whisker, montana and leeches.

Various methods have been successful from Floating through to Sinking lines.
