Fishing Report 25th July 2016



Couple of great fish caught before the warm weather hit.

The 'Heat Wave' at the beginning of the week was not to the liking of our stock of fish as they developed into a new species, 'The Elusive Trout'
Those that did manage to catch fish, found them whilst drifting over deep water using intermediate lines and long leaders.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **0.92** with 68 fish caught by 74 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 3lb 4oz caught by Mr P Harding
The heaviest Brown was 3lb caught by Mr Goldthorpe

Top Spot

The most popular spots have been Fishtail creek, Dam wall and main basin.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were Black Lure, Green/Black Fritz, pink snakes, black buzzers and crunchers
Intermediate and sinking lines with long leaders have proved the most successful.
