Another good week, fish are still being caught in deeper water and a lot of them have been over 3lbs in weight. Don't forget we still have evening fishing available until Sunday 1st Sept.



Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **2.20** with 112 fish caught by 51 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow this week was 3 ½ lbs caught by Mr J Matthews in deep water on a booby. The heaviest brown was 2lbs 6oz and caught by Mr P Pearce on a montana at the North End.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been in the deeper sections of Stitch Plantation, Fishtail creek, Millfields, North End and drifting from the east side towards the middle of the reservoir around buoys 4,5 & 6.

Method & Flies

The most successful patterns are cats whiskers, red booby, green & black fritz, minnow and hot head damsel. Sinking lines have been a must this week. The fish are most certainly deep in the cooler water. Bright and sparkly fly patterns are also helping to entice the fish out of the weed beds.
