The heaviest rainbow this week was 8lbs caught on a black zonker by Mr Page.

The heaviest brown caught was 3lbs 2oz caught by Pete Eville.

The heaviest blue was caught by Mr Lupton.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been stone island, sailing club island, tower bank, Millfields, Upperfields bay, and fishtail creek.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns are bibio, black pennel, lead bugs, gold head montana, cats whisker, hot head damsels, black buzzers, zonkers and diawl bachs.

Most fish have been caught on floating and intermediate lines, close to the margins.
