The North end of the reservoir has become more and more popular as the week progressed, hopefully this will continue into next week! Fishing is until 4.30 for this final week so make sure to get your boat booked for your last trip of 2015!

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was 3.71 with 278 fish caught by 75 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 4lb 7oz caught by Mr Pearce
The heaviest Brown was 3lb caught by Mr Batteson

Top Spot

Popular areas this week have been up at the north end, drifting across the main lake and along the Eastern bank.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were Pink Snake, Cat's Whisker, Ace of Spades, Minkie
Intermediate lines caught the most fish this week
