Fishing Report 27th July 2015



3lbs 4oz rainbow caught by Mr Shaw on Thursday.

Windy conditions at the beginning of the week made catching difficult however, Wednesday produced some good results fishing around fishtail creek. On Friday Mr Naylor had success dapping with Daddy Long legs landing 9 fish to the boat, and his partner surpassing that with 14 to the boat all on dries.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **3.55** with 220 fish caught by 62 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbows were 3lbs 8oz caught by Mr Daniels and Mr Neale.

The Heaviest brown caught was 1lbs 5oz caught by Chris Hodgkiss on a hares ears in fishtail creek.

We also had recording of several blues caught

Top Spot

Popular areas this week have been brown ale bay, fish tail creek, upperfields bay, buoy 4, millfields and dam wall, Anglers are moving out into the deeper water as the water temperatures rise.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were Cats whisker, Crunchers, Damsel tadpole, black tadpole, boobies, hares ears, blobs, sedges and daddies.

Most anglers have used intermediate and sinking lines.
