The rod average for this week was 7.9 with 474 fish caught by 60 anglers.

The heaviest Rainbow was 4lb 2oz caught by Mr Harding The heaviest Brown was 2lb 9oz caught by Mr Rushton

Top Spot

Popular areas this week have been Half Moon, Tower Bank, Sheepwash, Fishtail Creek. Although many anglers reported catching fish all over the reservoir.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were Orange Blob, Black and Green lures, Cat's Whiskers, Buzzers and Pink Snakes. Slow sink, intermediate and floating have proved popular
