We have had another busy week at the fishery with two competitions and many anglers out enjoying the mild temperatures for this time of year.

The rod average for last week was **5.34** with 326 fish caught by 61 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow this week was 4lbs caught by Mr Crompton on a Montana near the tower at Millfields.. The heaviest brown was caught and released by Mr Neale using a black dabble on a floating line.

Top Spots

The most popular spots this week were Fishtail creek, Millfields, Upperfields bay, Stitch Plantation and Sailing Club island.

Method & Flies

The most popular fly patterns used this week have still been gold head montana, black & green lure, Orange gold head blob, cormorant, diawl bach, cats whisker and dog nobbler. A variety of lines have been used however most fish have been caught on intermediate lines.

Opening Times

The fishery is now open 8.30 am – 4pm until the 24th November 2013. This will mean that we only have morning or day tickets available. We do advise that you make a booking in advance as we have had a few disappointed customers this week. Also don't forget to leave us your contact telephone number in case we need to get in touch due to bad weather.

All boats are back to the jetty by 4.00pm
