The rod average for this week was **4.91** with 466 fish caught by 95 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 4lbs caught by Mr Matthews The heaviest Brown was 2lbs 4oz caught by Mr P Pearce. We also had a lovely 3lb blue caught by Mr D Barker.

Top Spot

Popular areas this week have been Tower Bank, Halfmoon field, Fishtail creek, Upperfields bay, Watersports Island, Dam wall and Millfields. Anglers are moving out into the deeper water as the water temperatures rise.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were small Black Buzzers, Shipmans buzzer, Cruncher, Damsel Nymph, Diawl Bach, Gold Head Montana, Bibio, Claret Hoppers, Black Spider, Ace of Spades and Cats whisker, It's been great to see more fish caught on dry flies this week.

Most anglers have used intermediate and floating lines.
