## Carsington Fishing Report

29<sup>th</sup> September 2014



*September Sunset*

It has been a mixed week out on the water this week. The weekend has fished really well with Saturday's rod average being 7.3 however the week has averaged out at 3.79.

Fishing at the North end of the reservoir has been good this week with many boats drifting from the West shore, Tower bank and Brown ale bay to the middle.

**Please note - Fishing will be restricted to the nature reserve area only on Tuesday 30th September**

### Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **3.79** with 231 fish caught by 61 anglers.

### Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 4lbs by Mr Matthews on a daddy at the North End.

The heaviest brown caught was 1lb 8ozs by Mr Griffin on a sedge near Far bank.

### Top Spots

The most successful areas have been Upperfields Bay, Sitch plantation, Fishtail creek, Buoy 4, 5, 7, 8, Brown ale bay and Tower bank.

### Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were minkie, white fritz, orange lure, daddy long legs, sedges, hoppers, bibio, black & green lure, cats whisker, montana and hothead damsel.

Most fish have been caught using floating and intermediate lines.
