Once again another good week of fishing with many blues being caught and several rainbows of 4lbs and above. Please note, we are fully booked for this coming Saturday 7th October due to our Autumn Open Competition.



Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **3.89** with 218 fish caught by 56 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 3lbs 10oz caught by Pete Eville The heaviest Brown was 4lbs 12oz caught by Richard Budd

<u>Top Spot</u>

The most popular spots have been around the Main Basin, Dam Wall, Fish Tail Creek, Millfields, Sailing Club Island and Buoys 3, 4 & 5.

Methods & Flies

The most successful flies were pink snakes, black and green lures, orange blobs, daddies, minkies, bibios and black fritz.

Most anglers have fished on a drift using intermediate or slow sinking lines with dry flies.

Cliff Beardmore's 2lb 2oz brown caught near the dam wall on the dap.

25 Year Anniversary Tagged Fish Competition

To mark Carsington Water's 25th Anniversary we have launched a tagged fish competition. We have released 25 tagged fish into the reservoir with a number of prizes to be won for those caught throughout the 2017 season. To date 15 of the 25 fish have been caught so lots more prizes up for grabs.
