

Fishing Report 30th March 2015



Fishing has proved tougher this week with a slight drop in the rod average putting us back on par with this time last season. The wet and windy conditions over the weekend didn't put off all of our anglers with all who went out reporting to have caught.

We have one boat left for our Spring open on Saturday 11th April. The relaxed format of the day with fishing allowed in known pairs is proving ever popular so get in touch fast if you want to bag the last boat! Bookings can be made online through the link further down the page.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **7.76** with 396 fish caught by 51 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 4lbs 2oz by Mr Margett. Several browns were caught this week but no weights were recorded.

Top Spots

Most areas of the reservoir have proved popular this week. Fishtail Creek, Tower Bank and Millfields have all proved to be the most popular with anglers catching nearer the margins.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were montana, booby, minkie, black and green lures, cats whisker and buzzers. Most anglers have used sinking lines on a fast retrieve.
