Fishing Report 31st August 2015

We are pleased to report that the rod average has still stayed reasonably high at 4 for the last week. Fishing has been similar to the previous week with most fish being caught in deeper areas, moving out from the weed beds towards the middle of the water, with many fish caught whilst drifting.

Please note on Thursday 3rd September fishing is only available until 6.30pm.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **4.03** with 238 fish caught by 59 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow was 3lb 8oz caught by Mr D Oliver.

The heaviest blue was 3lb 9oz caught by Mr P Harding.

We have no record of browns caught this week.

Top Spot

Popular areas this week have been drifting across the main basin towards Fishtail creek and Tower Bank. Anglers are now moving out into the deeper water as the water temperatures rise.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were minkie, black or orange blobs, green fritz, cats whisker, montana and black hopper. There has been a real mix of lines used this week from floating on a drift to sinking with a slow retrieve.
