Fishing Report 3rd August 2015



4lbs 5oz rainbow caught by Mr Margott

Best results this week came from fishing sinking lines whilst drifting across the main basin to or from Fishtail Creek. Sunday evening saw Mr Booth return 14 fish using Dries (Claret Bits).

Drifting on the eastern edges between the line of orange buoys also produced good results.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **2.9** with 135 fish caught by 47 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow was 4lb 5oz caught by Mr Margott (pictured)
The Heaviest brown caught was 2lb 8oz caught by Mr Cozens

Top Spot

Popular areas this week have been brown ale bay, fish tail creek, upperfields bay, buoy 4, millfields and dam wall, Anglers are moving out into the deeper water as the water temperatures rise.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were Cats whisker, Crunchers, Black Fritz, Viva, Cormorant, Minkie, Zulu, Black or White Lures and Dry Flies (Claret Bits)
Most anglers have used intermediate and sinking lines.
