Another difficult week for some whilst those who did find the fish managed to catch their bag limit and more. Fish have been found across most of the reservoir with varying methods and techniques used successfully.

Remember to show our rangers the fish with tag attached, or a photo showing the tagged fish and angler, on the day so we can verify the catch! There are 12 left to catch by the end of the season!

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **3.44** with 179 fish caught by 52 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 5lbs 4oz caught by J Matthews.

The heaviest Brown was 3lbs 1oz caught by David Hilton Barber.

Top Spot

The most popular spots have been around Fishtail, Sailing club & Watersports Island however the main basin is also showing results.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were both wet and dry flies including nymphs, damsel, snakes, black & green lure, orange blobs, black buzzer and hoppers.

The main method this week has been sinking lines and sinktips.

25 Year Anniversary Tagged Fish Competition

To mark Carsington Water's 25th Anniversary we have launched a tagged fish competition. We have released 25 tagged fish into the reservoir with a number of prizes to be won for those caught throughout the 2017 season.
