

Carsington Fishery Report 3rd May 2013

There has been a slight reduction in the rod average this week to 7.64 however this is still much higher for this time of year in comparison to past seasons.

The weather has been a little kinder to us over the later part of the week and the weekend and the sun even shined for the 3rd competition of the season for the Carsington Fly Fishers. See below a link to the results for their competition resulting in a overall competition rod average of 5.1.

Number of fish landed = 86

Rod average = 5.1

Total weight of fish landed = 184 lbs. 10 oz.

Average fish weight = 2lb. 12oz.

Best Rainbow/Brown

There were 2 equal heaviest rainbows this week of 4lbs 8oz caught by Ray Crompton and Andrew Tildesley both caught on buzzers.

The heaviest brown this week was 3lbs 8oz caught by Denis Brinicombe.

Top Spots

The top spots this week have been Shinningford Creek, Tower Bank, Fishtail creek, Sailing club island and Watersports island.

Method & Flies

The most popular fly patterns used this week have mainly black buzzers, daiwl bach, orange fritz, hot head damsel and black cats whisker. Mostly intermediate and floating lines have been used this week.
